Summer Take Home and Chromebook Damage/Loss Program
2017-2018 School Year

The educational program at your student's school includes a Chromebook that will be issued to your student for their use at school and home. We are very excited to be able to make these powerful tools available to our students. We also understand that both students and parents are concerned about keeping these tools secure and in good working order.

Like textbooks, team uniforms and other school property issued to your student, there is a responsibility to take appropriate care of these valuable resources. The Chromebook is no different, but it does represent an increased cost to the district and liability to students and parents. We know that loss and accidents will happen. District policies, regulations and practices require that a fine be levied to cover the repair or replacement cost of district property. With computing devices, like the Chromebooks, the cost of loss or damage can be significant.

The district has developed a Summer Take Home and Chromebook Damage/Loss Program as a way for families to reduce the financial risk if a Chromebook is accidentally damaged, stolen, vandalized or lost. Participation in these programs is completely voluntary.

SUMMER STUDENT SUPPORT: Student Chromebook tech support will be provided Monday – Friday (excluding holidays) from 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM at the following location: Edmonds School District, Technology Department, 20420 68th Ave W, Lynnwood, WA 98036. Call the following number for telephone support and/or to schedule an on-site appointment (425) 431-1211.

SUMMER CHROMEBOOK RETURN: If, due to an unforeseen circumstances, you need to return the student Chromebook, please return it to the Student Chromebook tech support office at the following location: Edmonds School District, Technology Department, 20420 68th Ave W, Lynnwood, WA 98036. Call the following number to schedule an on-site appointment (425) 431-1211. If your student leaves the district and does not return the Chromebook it will be reported as stolen (see **THEFT** below).

COVERAGE AND BENEFIT: This program covers the Chromebook loaned to the student against all accidental damage, theft, vandalism or loss for one (1) school year*. It also includes one (1) ESD District Logo Case and one (1) power cord for one school year. This program does NOT cover intentional misuse, abuse or neglect by any household members. If the student did not exercise proper care and/or take appropriate precautions, as described in the student handbook, and this behavior resulted in damage to or loss of the Equipment, the cost of the repair or replacement will be the responsibility of the student/parent.

If the Chromebook is vandalized or accidentally damaged, it will be repaired at no cost.

If the Chromebook is lost, the student will be issued a replacement Chromebook, **upon payment of \$150 deductible**. However, the parent will not be eligible to enroll in this program for a second time in the same school year and will be fully responsible for replacement or repair costs associated with the second Chromebook.

In the event that the lost Chromebook is recovered in working condition, the deductible will be refunded.

THEFT - If the Chromebook is stolen, the Edmonds School District will require that a police report be submitted. Fraudulent reporting of theft will be turned over to the police for investigation. A student making a false report will also be subject to disciplinary action.

If you choose not to enroll in the Chromebook Damage/Loss Program, you will be responsible for the full cost for repair due to damage or replacement of the Chromebook.
