CHROMEBOOK SUMMER CHECK OUT

Edmonds School District will offer parents /guardians of high school students, who are returning for the 2017-2018 school year, the option to allow their students to keep their Chromebook over the summer. Participation in this program is voluntary.

Parents/guardians will need to opt in to the program on behalf of their student(s) by completing a form that requires the parent/guardian signature, selecting their choice for the loss/damage coverage, and paying the damage/loss coverage fee. The summer check out period will extend through end of the 2017-2018 school year. Forms will soon be available for download or pick up in the EWHS Main Office. Stay tuned for further information.

Important - If a Chromebook is in disrepair or has any issues, it is important to tend to this immediately to avoid any delay with Chromebook Collection - Check Out/In. Please be sure to address repair issues right away, before check in, with Chris Comstock, EWHS Student Chromebook Tech. Fines will be assessed accordingly for equipment returned in poor condition.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION 2017 SENIORS

Please clear all fines/fees ASAP: Updated School Board Policy as noted below:

Active student fines and fees will remain in the system for collection and will be subject to the following:

- A. *Official transcripts and diplomas will be withheld.*
- B. *The student will be excluded from participating in extracurricular activities, including athletics.*
- C. *The student will be excluded from participating in optional school activities including dances and excursions.*
- D. *The student will be excluded from graduation ceremonies.*

Inactive student fines and fees will remain in the system and requests for official transcripts will be denied until restitution is made.

Senior Chromebook Collection – Week of June 12th

Class of 2017 students will be returning Chromebooks by June 14th and 15th to the check in station in the EWHS Library.

As with all fines, seniors will **not** be cleared for graduation if their Chromebook is not returned in good, working condition. Fines will be assessed accordingly for equipment returned in poor condition. Any Chromebook not returned will automatically revert to a full fine of \$305, thereby implementing the School Board Policy described above.

Account	When change will occur	Recommended steps you should take
Google account (e.g.tanjoh000@edmonds15.org) email address and contents of Google Drive	This account will be disabled in early September	You should let people who send you email to this account know that you have a new email address. If you want to retain any files in your district Google Drive, you can use Google Takeout to create an archive. Here is a document with instructions on how to do this. You can also share it with your personal Google account and make copies of what you want to keep. Here is a video with instructions on how to do this.
Skyward account (ex. tan joh000)	This account will be disabled in mid-July	No action
Network account (ex. tanjoh000) and contents of your digital locker (Z: drive)	This account will be disabled in mid-July	If you need any information on your digital locker, you should copy it to a USB drive before the end of the school year.

ATHLETICS INFORMATION FOR FALL 2017-18 SCHOOL YEAR

Fall Sports Start August 21, 2017; Football starts Wednesday, August 16th. Please submit your athletic forms on line via RankOneSport. No hard copies of forms will be accepted *, students can submit forms 24/7 on RankOne using their school issued Chromebooks. The 2017-18 school year is now open.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Before the first practice athletes must have completed:

- 1) All **3 forms** on Rank One Sport
- 2) Must turn in a hard copy of a current medical / physical examination (if not on file)
- 3) All EWHS **finances must be paid**. Payment can be made in the main office.
- 4) Previous semester grade requirement: must have attempted 2.5 credits.

Before the athlete competes in a game or contest he or she must:

- 1) Purchase a **\$50.00 ASB card**
- 2) Have passed or be passing **five** full credit classes.
- 3) Pay a **Sport participation fee - \$100.00 (per season) *if a student-athlete qualifies for free and reduced lunch, his/her sport participation fee is waived. Must provide letter from Food Services.**

Summer School Transportation

Free transportation will be provided from neighborhood schools to Edmonds-Woodway High School in order to attend the program either the first session, second session or both. Stay tuned, route information to be posted shortly.

Districtwide Text Messaging

The Edmonds School District is adding text messaging to our mass communication system. The system will be configured to send text message notifications to family member cell phone numbers who have agreed to receive them. To receive text messages, phone numbers must be in Skyward attached to student records.

There are two ways you may Opt-In:

- Send "Y" or "Yes" via text message to our short code number 67587
- Reply to the opt-in text message on May 11 With a "Y" or Yes"

The District may only send only one text message to phone numbers in Skyward with Opt-in invitation text messages. That special text will be sent on May 11, 2017, to make it easy to respond.

But any time before or after that day you may opt-in yourself by texting 67587. Once opted-in, participants will receive confirmation text messages.

This spring, the District will exclusively use text messaging for emergency communication. Next school year, schoolwide texting of important topics and events will begin with even greater options for families to choose communication methods.

COLLEGE AND CAREER CENTER NEWS

SAT and ACT dates announced for 2017-18. SAT has added an August test date for this summer and ACT has added a July test date for summer of 2018. Seniors who have not taken an exam by the start of their senior year should plan to register for one of the fall test dates in order to meet college application deadlines. Acing College Program: For seniors interested in or planning on attending Edmonds CC after graduation. We have two sessions left. We will be holding the Accuplacer placement Exam on June 8th at 2pm in EWHS Room D201. And our final meeting will take place on June 8th during advisory in the Career Center where students will be able to register for their classes. Representatives from Edmonds CC will be at both sessions. Open to any interested senior.

Tech Prep: Many of our courses taught at EWHS are also Tech Prep Courses. Your student may be able to earn college credit. Students must register by the deadline, pay the fee (if applicable) and must earn a "B" or better in the course:

Deadline for Edmonds Tech Prep registrations is June 8th.

Deadline for Tech Prep College Connections Courses is June 15th and the one-time per year fee of \$46 must also be paid by June 15th.

The following courses earn credit through Tech Prep College Connections. There is an annual fee of \$46. If you register for multiple courses, you still only pay the one-time fee this year of \$46.

1. Select Register Now! under Student Links: <http://sers.techprepwa.org/>
2. Select Students Click Here.

If you are a returning student (have received Tech Prep credits before), follow the prompts on the main screen to access your existing Tech Prep account.

If you are a new student (have NOT received Tech Prep credits before), select Create an Account from the column on the left:

- Enter your student information—red mark indicates required fields
- Important! Include a valid, active e-mail address as this will be our primary way of contacting you!
- Click on Submit. Your account access information (user name and password) will be sent to your e-mail address on file

3. Select Register for Classes.
4. On this screen, please select ONLY the following:

Your school district from the School District drop down list

Your high school from the High School drop down list

IMPORTANT: PLEASE LEAVE ALL OTHER FIELDS AT THEIR DEFAULT SETTING

5. Click on Go Search! -class listing will show at bottom of screen.
6. Click “Reg” box next to class name (green check mark will appear), then Register button at top left. If there are multiple sections of this class taught by more than one teacher, you will need to check the box by the teacher in whose section you are enrolled.
7. Select Save & Register - registration information and confirmation will be sent to your e-mail address on file.
8. Select Return to Student Home to select another class, or log out.
9. Pay the \$46 fee if it is a Tech Prep College Connections course (not Edmonds CC. Courses with credit through Edmonds CC are free this year.
