

# Getting started on Smartbacc

## STEP 1: Logging on

Go to your school's Smartbacc website e.g. <http://edmondswoodway.smartbacc.com>


To login click on the **Login** icon, it can be found in both the top right hand corner and centre of the page. Login using your username and password.







To view a study guide click on preferred subject






