



EDMONDS-WOODWAY ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME CRITERIA

The Edmonds Woodway High School Athletic Hall of Fame exists to recognize and honor student athletes, coaches, teams and sports contributors for their achievements and/or contributions to the Edmonds High School, Woodway High School, and Edmonds-Woodway High School Athletics programs.

EWHS Hall of Fame Committee:

- The EWHS Athletic Director will serve at the Chairperson
- Prospective Hall of Fame Committee members must submit an application to the athletic director.
- The secretary of the committee is a non-voting member and will be responsible for keeping historical files on all nominees.
- This committee is responsible for choosing from the individuals and teams recommended through the application process. The committee will use the nomination criteria to determine inductees.

NOMINATION CRITERIA:

ATHLETES: An athlete is eligible for nomination into the EWHS Athletic Hall of Fame five years after graduation.

Elements considered when inducting Athletes:

- Made significant contributions in athletics at Edmonds High, Woodway High, or EWHS
- Won league, District, State Title or a member of a team that did.
- Received All League, All-Area, or All-State honors.
- Placed in the top 8 at a WIAA State Tournament
- Competed in multiple State sports and/or competed in multiple State Tournaments
- Participated in post-high school athletics (university, professional, recreational)
- Holds school record (s)
- Lead a major statistical category in League or State

COACHES: A coach is eligible for nomination into the EWHS Athletic Hall of Fame 3 years after retiring from coaching. To be eligible coaches must also have coached at Edmonds High, Woodway High, and/or EWHS for at least 5 years.

Elements considered when inducting Coaches:

- Made a positive contribution to the overall EHS, WHS, EWHS Athletic Program
- Had a positive impact on the student-athletes with whom he/she coached
- Inducted into a county, state or National Hall of Fame
- Served on the State/National Coaches Board for a sport
- Won one or more League Titles
- Won one or more District Title
- Won one or more State Titles
- Coached multiple sports

TEAMS: Teams are eligible for nomination into the EWHS Athletic Hall of Fame 7 years after seniors on the team have graduated.

- Placed in top eight at a State Competition
- Won a District Title
- Won a State Title
- Undefeated season/75% or higher winning percentage

COMMUNITY CONTRIBUTOR: Any individual who:

- Through working with the high school has helped contribute to the betterment of programs and/or growth of programs.
- Through working with the high school and/or school district has helped improve the playing experience/atmosphere for EHS, WHS, EWHS Athletes and coaches.

NOMINATION PROCESS:

- Nominations for consideration into the EWHS Athletic Hall of Fame may be by committee members or by public nominations. Applications for nominations are available in the EWHS athletic office and online on the Edmonds-Woodway Athletic Homepage.
- The number of inductees for each category per year are as follows:
 - Athletes 4-6
 - Coaches 6-8
 - Teams: up to 2
 - Community Contributor 1-2

Hall of Fame Timeline:

- Nominations open 2/1/15—5/1/15
- May—nominations go to committee
- June—Committee votes—Announcement of new Inductees
- Once nominated, nominees will be active for 3 years. After 3 years those not selected will be placed on an inactive list and be eligible for re-nomination.
- Selection will be based on scoring rubric focused on nomination criteria.
- October—Ceremony at EWHS/recognition at halftime during Friday night Football Game
